



AIRPORT INSTALLS SPEED HUMPS TO CALM TRAFFIC

HYANNIS – Caution! Speed humps ahead at the airport.

In an effort to slow speeding motorists on busy roadways near Barnstable Municipal Airport, crews have installed three speed humps. Two are located on the new airport access road—actually an extension of Barnstable Road— and the third is on the circular drive that serves the passenger terminal.

“Some motorists have been speeding recklessly over these roads, endangering themselves and pedestrians,” said Airport Manager Roland “Bud” Breault. “Speed humps are calming devices designed to slow the traffic. The posted speed limit is 20 mph but few drivers seem to be paying attention.”

New painted roadway lines and warning signs have been installed to warn motorists of the humps which are called “speed tables” by traffic engineers.

The Barnstable Road humps have been installed near Cape Air Hangar 2 and between the entrance to Rectrix Aviation and Airport Road. The circular road hump is between the terminal and the air traffic control tower.

Motorists are advised to please slow down and use caution when approaching the humps.
