SUMMER SEASONAL SERVICE BETWEEN NEW YORK AND HYANNIS BEGINS IN MAY

This year's season runs through early fall, 2016

(Hyannis, MA) March 31, 2016 – Travelers flying between New York's JFK Airport and Hyannis, MA on Cape Cod will again have a direct option as JetBlue Airlines begins their seasonal service between the two airports on Thursday, May 12. The popular airline will be offering nonstop flights Thursday through Monday between May 12 and June 16. Daily flights to New York will begin on June 16, aboard a 100-seat Embraer E190 twin-engine jet, an aircraft with a reputation for safety, as well as quiet takeoffs and landings.

"We are thrilled passengers traveling between New York's JFK Airport and Hyannis will have this direct option again this summer. The service has proved to be very popular for passengers who not only are headed to Cape Cod but also for those traveling around the world by connecting through the JFK Airport," says Barnstable Municipal Airport Manager Bud Breault.

Inbound flights from New York are scheduled to arrive in Hyannis at 12:30PM; flights are due to depart for New York about 40 minutes later, at 1:06PM.

This year JetBlue will also be extending their weekly service into the early fall with twice weekly (Friday and Sunday) service from September 8th through October 11th.

"Business and leisure travelers have told us the service between New York and Hyannis has been a great addition," says Robin Hayes, JetBlue's President and CEO. "We're encouraged by the support we're receiving from Barnstable Airport and look forward to a long relationship servicing this route."

Airport officials have cooked up some changes this year and are excited to announce the availability of a slice of Cape Cod life at the airport, with the addition of The Centerville Pie Company Café, now located adjacent to the JetBlue terminal.

“Centerville Pie Company is well known to foodies around the country for their exceptional pies,” says Breault. “We are thrilled to have this café open as an option to travelers looking for a quick bite to eat in the terminal or as a takeout option.”
