

IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM UNDERWAY AT AIRPORT

Rental Cars Relocated; Bank Building Demolished

Hyannis – Work is underway at Barnstable Municipal Airport on the first phase of a \$30 million program to replace outdated facilities at the Commonwealth’s third busiest airport.

Rental cars have been relocated to a temporary lot on an aircraft deicing ramp inside the security fence, and a new fence has been erected. The present rental car lot became part of the construction zone for a new \$6.7 million air traffic control tower to be built by Suffolk Construction Co. of Boston. The roadway from Rte. 28 adjacent to the former bank building has been restricted to return of rental cars only. And an airport staff parking lot has been moved as well.

Airport Manager Roland “Bud” Breault said other existing vehicle entrance and exit ways and passenger parking lots will be changed later.

Other signs of progress will include the demolition of the former TD Bank building near the Airport Rotary and the former Terminal II building that formerly housed Nantucket Shuttle Airlines ticket counters and Transportation Security Administration offices. Nantucket Shuttle Airlines now occupies counter space inside the main terminal, and the TSA has been relocated
