ON EARLY SUCCESS OF JETBLUE’S NEW YORK SERVICE**

The daily JetBlue service between New York and Barnstable Municipal Airport is off to an excellent start. Since its launch June 26, planes have been consistently around 80 percent full - in both directions. On some days, it has been better than that.

We are thrilled with its early success, especially how eagerly passengers departing from Cape Cod have embraced the service.

JetBlue’s choice of Hyannis as its 86th flight destination has so far proved to be on target, reflecting the untapped demand for air service from Hyannis to points beyond Boston and the islands.

Let’s hope this fast start will help make the case for shoulder-season and year-round service to New York and other popular destinations. The airport commission and our air marketing service consultant are working toward that. – *Bud Breault*
