

Hyannis – With its new passenger terminal nearing completion, Barnstable Municipal Airport has put into place a new traffic pattern in and out of the current terminal. The entrance off Barnstable Road near the Airport Rotary has been closed, and all incoming and existing traffic has been re-routed.

Traffic approaching the airport from Exit 6 of the Mid-Cape Highway or Route 132 should use Attucks Lane and follow it to Airport Road where a second a left turn will lead to the airport via the newly-opened access road.

Route 28 traffic from West Yarmouth now uses a new airport entrance ramp across from the Nantucket Sound store and follows a newly-constructed looping roadway to the right to reach the terminal.

Motorists leaving the terminal will return to Barnstable Road and turn left toward the rotary or right toward Hinckley Road and Airport Road via the access road.

The main airport parking entrance and ticket vending machine have been relocated to the right down Barnstable Road, across front of the new passenger terminal. Motorists still will be able to park free for up to 30 minutes to drop off or pick up passengers.
