



**RON PERSUITTE RE-ELECTED TO FOURTH TERM AS CHAIRMAN OF

HYANNIS – Ronald Persuitte of Barnstable Village has been re-elected unanimously to a fourth term as chairman of the Barnstable Municipal Airport Commission.

At the commission's June 23rd meeting, John Griffin also was unanimously elected to a second term as vice chairman, and Robert O'Brien was chosen unanimously for another term as clerk of the commission.

Persuitte (PURR-SUIT'-TEE) has been a member since 2007 and previously served as head of the commission's finance subcommittee. He owns an investment planning and counseling service in Hyannis.

"I appreciate the opportunity to continue to lead the commission at this challenging time for the airport when we are seeking to increase both airline passengers and operating revenue," he said. "I'm grateful to my colleagues for their support."

Griffin, who lives in Centerville, has served on the airport commission since 1998. He currently heads the commission's Infrastructure and Marketing Subcommittee. He is a licensed private pilot.

Airport Manager Roland "Bud" Breault was given a three-year extension to his current contract.
